Whether I am working the compost in the fields, running the tractor, or leading community conversation, it is believing in yourself and having the courage to step outside your comfort zone that allows great leaders and upcoming leaders to remain steadfast in the face of daunting tasks. As I have stated earlier, it is our goal through Earthbound for our leadership to send a strong message to the community that female leadership transcends gender boundaries."
