- Dryer Lint (ONLY if none or non chemical dryer sheets used!)

- Fur (pet grooming)
- F Hair/Nails (human & pet)
- Paper Towels/ Tissues
- **▼** Q-tips cardboard middles
- **■** Tooth Pastes

MISCELLANEOUS

- ASTM D-6400/6800 compostable products
- Cellulose sponges

Meat and Dairy Storage:

Put meat/dairy in sealed containers in your fridge until your organics
bag is almost full. Empty the materials into your bag for collection.

Maximize Bag Space

Bags can hold up to 3 ice cream pales full of organics.

Compost In the Bathroom!

Use a countertop bin or other container in your bathroom.

Free Liquids in Your Bag? Simply use soiled napkins, paper towels, etc. to line your Earthbound bag in the countertop organics bin.
